Road layout old – Woking Rd/Camphill etc. W. Byfleet centre	Single Lane Rd – redesign
Crossing Parvis Rd (pedestrians)	Pedestrian crossing (hedging in middle of Rd)
Traffic buildup at Oyster lane roundabout	Yellow box
School Run – Oakfield/Ryrford + Byfleet schools – gridlocked in morning up to 15mins in narrow Roads	Ban cars from close to school – alternatives like park + stride Look at possible Road solutions. More responsibility from parents, walk or cycle to school School warnings in SAT NAV (Use VAS instead)
Maderia Road – speeding cut through	More speed management near schools
Lloyds Lane/Pyrford speedinh (20mph limit) No pavement on Pyrford Rd pass Floyds Lane Jctn.	More community speedwatch (Info on processes)
Urban speeding	Reduction to 20mph in some roads. Narrow Rds, near shops & schools
Monument Rd roadworks – people using Builders centre for U-turns. Volume of traffic	Road layout needs assessment. Agency coordination on road works
Byfleet Coop – Blocking Rd outside – Traffic build up	Needs assessment currenty (parking bays but double parked) Parking opposite needs to be used
Pedestrian crossing needed (elderly). Outside St Mary's and at Barnes Wallis drive	PC
Speeding on Parvis Rd/East end of High Rd	More speedwatch volunteers
Old Ave/A245. right turn for buses (mini) (using middle of Rd + Speeding)	Assessment. Possible mini roundabout
Building work – flats towards Sheerwater boulders traffic parked on pavement. Problem for vehicles and pedestrians (also the school traffic has the same problem)	Approach Building Co/School possibly with PC/PCSO
Lack of cycle route Oyster Lane quite narrow	Alternative cycle routes (to station in particular)
Purford Rd - speeding	Speeding camera at Floyds Lane
Parking between War memorial and Bank on double yellow. Including vans due to lack of parking	Double line to be added (When?). Publicise additional parking. Make Byfleet one-way (needs consultation) + Maderia/Old Woking Rd one way?

Speeding Byfleet village (High Rd)	
Rubbish collection, lorries too large (Old Orchard), drive on pavement	?to contractor (solution for Walnut Avenue)
Groups of youths on scooters – Byfleet village mostly evenings (Modified and very noisy) 4 regularly. Last 2 months particularly bad	Alternative location Noise control
Hockfield avenue – double parking	Enforcement by police/parking attendant
Martyrs Lane at weekends. Cut through -Traffic build-up – dangerous driving	Queing lane (?) Warning signs at weekends Make one way
Weymead/Parvis Rd	Traffic assessment
Robts in Byfleet have different numbers of keep left islands (for crossing pedestrians)	Would like to know why?
