Problems	Solution
North Road gets congested due to Mosque traffic on Friday evenings	Suggest less activity Mosque to promote other ways of getting to the Mosque (other than cars)
Making a right turn on East Hill – Old Woking rd can be dangerous	Roundabouts as possible solution
Comment about other right hand turns	
Board School Rd and Boundary Rd – The narrow roads are dangerous (due to CPZ parked cars) and cars travelling fast	Make this area one way
Maybury hill cars speeding (and other roads in the area)	Larger signs on road Permanent cameras to monitor area (Northampton) Signs that light up VAS but keep them in place. Speed Humps – Can cause problems
An issue with cars wanting to turn right into Eve Rd from Maybury Rd so they turn around in the industrial estate	Clearer signage to explain what is needed. Better traffic flow Clearer arrow on traffic lights Consider times when you can turn right Signage showing preferred route
Hoebidge School area can be dangerous for cyclists and pedestrians	Campaign for a footpath in this area along Old Woking Rd and White Rose Lane

cannot turn left at the end at the traffic lights	budget to pay for some improvements
Property developments will need to be addressed on Maybury Hill otherwise major problems caused by traffic (lack of parking spaces)	Improve bus services including frequency Survey from residents about where they need people to go
Speeding taxis (when a passenger) along Oriental Rd	
Decisions about single bay parking can cause traffic disruptions, especially near road junctions	
Maybury Rd, Arnold Rd, Monument Rd and Maybury Arch traffic	Relocate traffic lights in Arnold Rd further up by the bridge
White Rose Lane, Heathside Crescent, change of zebra crossing is a concern when turning left	Consider yellow hatching Use keep clear signs and enforce them Can traffic wardens be empowered to issue fixed penalty notices
Vehicles can end up bumping into bridge near former James Walker site	
Vehicles in Maybury Rd need permits but problems caused with other residents who ignore being issued tickets	Enforce people who abuse the system
Vehicle vandalism when people come out of pubs/clubs in Park Rd, Maybury Rd and Walton Rd	
Extending of no parking zone survey was undertaken so what is the outcome?	
Traffic hotspots due to local issues such as schools and other churches	
General Speeding	Neighbourhood watch speed zones More 20mph zones Educate Motorists
